It has been my experience that taking classes greatly improves your carving skills. I have also realized that one must be willing to invest in such classes if one wants to become a better carver. In fact, I am still taking classes to improve my skills. Saturday classes at the club are a good thing, but it is really hard to get anything constructive done in only a couple of hours of instruction. Please give my proposal some serious thought and give me some feedback.

I know that summer is a busy time of the year, but please set aside time to come to our club meetings and participate in our activities. Also, remember to invite a friend and encourage those whom you haven't seen for a while to come back. It only takes a phone call.

Are you a Doane Newbie?
