John enjoyed super modified car racing, treasure hunting, running Burke Machine & Welding, and teaching woodcarving over the road, building Nebrastik rustic furniture, building and restoring old cars and hotrods, playing and singing music. He authored two woodcarving books. John culminated his love of woodcarving by being named 2009 Woodcarver of the Year by Woodcarving Illustrated Magazine. He will be remembered by many as a teacher, friend.

On May 26, 1973 John married Nancy Eichmeier in Ithaca, Nebraska. He sang "Follow Me" on his wedding day and Nancy and John have followed each other for 36 years.
