Wow another month come and gone and another newsletter deadline is here. What should I pontificate about this month. Well I guess I will mention the club picnic May 5th at camp Brewster. We hopefully will have a good turnout and the weather will be good. I will mention if you win one of the wonderful raffle prizes donated by someone PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO THANK THEM by email or a nice card or a personal thank you. It is **Rude** not to thank them and it makes getting donations that much tougher. So take the 2 minutes and say "Thank You" the people who donate want a little bit of appreciation. Ok now that I have that off my chest I will move on. We still have some openings for Doane if you haven't tried it, you really should, it is a fun week of carving and fellowship. We also have the application for the fall show in the newsletter so think about signing up for a table, or share a table with a friend, or we can help you find someone to share a table with and maybe make a new friend. On a lighter note it is nice to see the sun come out again and the rain stop. We need the rain, but too many rainy days in a row is kinda depressing. I will also throw out this *Remember* to wear your carving glove. One of the guys I was in class with recently cut their hand pretty good and he wasn't wearing a carving glove. I know a lot of carvers don't, but I do and it has saved me more than once. On that same note I make furniture as well as carve (well I try and carve) anyways. I am currently making a couple hope chests and the one I am working has hand cut dovetails for the case construction. The way I make them is you use a dovetail saw and cut the tails first and then you can chop or saw out the waste. This time I decided to saw out the waste with a coping saw. So I take my coping saw I have had for 40 years and start to saw out the waste between the pins. I am buzzing along and things are going great so I get to the last one and as I am cutting along I confused the waste between the tails with my thumb. In case you are wondering, coping saws will cut flesh, quite well. It also apparently takes a couple of seconds for your finger to send the message to your brain HEY STUPID YOU ARE CUTTING YOUR THUMB..... Message received. My coping saw and my thumb both survived, although it is amazing how much you use your thumb, not as much as my driving finger but a close second!!! George
